Master of Science in Supply Chain and Logistics Management (MS-SCLM)

Entry Requirements

Good academic record

Applicants to the Master of Science in Supply Chain and Logistics Management (MS-SCLM) program must have an undergraduate degree (bachelor's degree) from an accredited university with a CGPA of 3.0 and above on a 4.0 scale or its equivalent score.

Proficiency in English

A certificate of English proficiency such as: TOEFL with a minimum score of 550, or IELTS with a minimum score of 6.0 or another standardized, internationally recognized test approved by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research (MOHESR), UAE.

Assessment Interview

Eligible candidates will be required to attend an assessment interview with one of the faculty members from IMT Dubai. The acceptance decision will solely be based on the performance during that interview.

Work Experience

Although previous work experience is not a requirement for entry into the MS-SCLM program, applicants with previous work experience will be given preference during the selection process.

- 2 Submit all the required details which includes personal information, selected program and educational history etc. You are also required to email your supporting documents to admissions@imtdubai.ac.ae. Please note that any missing documents may delay your application process.
- 3 Once your documents are verified for eligibility and you have completed the admission procedures, if successful, you will receive an offer letter from the admissions department to confirm your seat in the program.

Required Documents

- Admissions essay reflecting the motivations for applying to IMT Dubai with a minimum of 300 words.
- Proof of English language proficiency.
- Resume / Curriculum Vitae.
- Passport size photographs (4).
- A copy of your UAE ID card (if applying from within the UAE).
- A scanned copy of the picture page of your passport (and Residence Visa for UAE residents).
- If completed: Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) or the Combined Admissions Test (CAT) results.
